Coordinator's Report

Workshops

- A participant in Art As Therapy was very enthusiastic and would be a great speaker or source of a testimonial

- Laura will do special outreach to men in our data base for the Best Dads workshop, June 8
- Diversity of participants seems to be increasing. Laura is connectining with some local groups, including 3 Muslim groups. FaceBook promotion is reaching other groups in Shelburne and Grand Valley.
- Local concerns related to eating disorders and human trafficking DCAFS is looking at some training for staff, but has nothing specific at this point.

Funding

- ED Peer Group has recently focused on Guelph-specific initiatives Buy Local, Give Local. It
